



Restylane Skinboosters™

Meso Injectable treatments are non-permanent hyaluronic acid dermal fillers that are designed to improve the skin's quality by boosting hydration levels deep inside the skin. To improve and increase its smoothness, elasticity and firmness. Available to use for a wide range of age groups and skin types.

Treatment can improve sun-damaged skin, fine lines and wrinkles, more mature skin, acne scars and areas of dehydration. The following areas can be treated with Skinboosters™

- Face
- Lips
- Backs of Hands
- Neck
- Décolletage
- Inner Arms

Treatment can also be used in conjunction with dermal fillers when hydration in addition to volume is required to achieve a good cosmetic outcome. Meso Injectable is usually delivered as a course of treatments, multiple sessions are recommended depending on skin type, and level of damage. This can be repeated every year for maximum benefit, but most people are satisfied with a top up treatment every 6 months after initial treatment.

Treatment regime Restylane Skinboosters will be first 3 syringes 2-3 weeks apart and 4th Syringe 2 months after 3rd, there is some flexibility but to achieve the best results you should try to do it to regular treatment sessions.

Local anaesthetic Cream will be applied to the area and Skinboosters™ will be administered by multiple Injections via a very fine needle, Skinboosters™ has local anaesthetic within the product to minimise pain but you may experience some discomfort.

Results are instant although continually improve with further sessions and due to the deep hydration and collagen stimulation. Following administration the area will be massaged to prevent any uneven areas, as the injections are superficial.

Side Effects & Recovery

Many people go back to their usual routine, but you should avoid activities which cause you to sweat such as exercise you should also avoid saunas and swimming for 48 hours. You may experience redness, swelling, tenderness and bruising following the treatment, this should recover within a few hours to a few days. You may use ice packs and/or antihistamines if swelling is excessive.

Other uncommon side effects include infection and lumpiness, please do not touch the treated area, if the swelling doesn't respond to ice pack and antihistamines and you notice an increase of heat and redness this could indicate infection please contact the clinic information is provided in your aftercare.
