

Viscoderm Hydrobooster

Viscoderm Hydrobooster is a stabilized hyaluronic acid injectable product able to offer a dual function; a biological process of hydration and tissue restructuring, together with a mechanical action to stretch the most superficial wrinkles, in a precise and natural way, resulting in its unique Hydrostretch action.

Hydrostretch action is made possible by the rheological properties of Viscoderm® Hydrobooster; the low gel stiffness and viscosity and high deformability guarantee optimal tissue integration and its use in different levels of the dermis, up to the most superficial layers. For this reason Viscoderm® Hydrobooster is particularly effective on the dynamic areas of the face (perioral, periocular and forehead).

Deep Hydration

- Improving elasticity, radiance and smoothness of the skin
- Biostructuring activity prolonged over time and safety guaranteed by the specific formula

Superficial Stretching

- Stretching superficial wrinkles for those with moderate to advanced signs of ageing (Glogau Scale Type 2 & 3)
- Particularly indicated for their dynamic areas of the face (perioral, periocular, forehead)

Viscoderm is administered via a very fine needle, via multi-puncture, micro-injection very superficially. This technique will cause bruising and it is advised that you must prepare for this side-effect.

Viscoderm can be administered as a stand-alone treatment or as a 2nd or 3rd Treatment alongside Profilla, your Practitioner will advise the best course of treatment for your specific needs.

Risks & Complications

- Pain, stinging or burning sensation
- Erythema (redness)
- Bruising & swelling
- Oedema
- Raised areas at the point of injection which may not resolve for up to 24 hours

Rare Risks & Complications

- More rarely acne-like formations
- Discolouration at the injection point
- Cold Sores
- Vascular Occlusion leading to necrosis
- Side-effects lasting up to 14 days



AFTERCARE

- There may be some tenderness, redness, swelling and bruising around the injection site. This is normal and will subside, usually within a few days.
- If swelling or pain persists or you are concerned, please contact the clinic as soon as possible
- Use a cold pack to reduce swelling and / or redness
- Do not massage or manipulate the treated area
- No recovery time is required and you can return to your daily activities immediately
- Avoid any further cosmetic procedures for 2 days after treatment
- Avoid wearing make-up for 12 hours post treatment
- Avoid extreme temperatures (hot or cold) for a minimum of 7 days after treatment (no saunas, steam rooms, sun beds or sun exposure)
- Apply a SPF30+ sunscreen
- Avoid strenuous exercise for 24 hours
- Avoid swimming for 48 hours
- Avoid alcohol for 24 hours after treatment
